





Maritime history and architecture are synonymous with Greenwich and a leisurely wander throws up a superb collection of impressive buildings from Inigo Jones, Christopher Wren and Nicholas Hawksmoor along with beautiful Georgian terraces and cobbled streets. The towering bronze-clad cone of the new planetarium by Allies & Morrison brings it all firmly into the 21st century.

Greenwich is stuffed with places to eat, drink and hang out including The Rivington Grill, Inc Bar, Greenwich Theatre, Greenwich Picturehouse, Greenwich Playhouse, and the (in)famous Up The Creek comedy club, to name but only a few. Plus the cerebral pleasures of Greenwich Park, the Thames and all things maritime.

The Sunday markets in Greenwich are one of London's real treats; a heady mix of arts, crafts, retro, antique & contemporary clothing, furniture and, well, stuff.

Down the road in Deptford, a completely different artisan scene with a bustling street market and innumerable studios, galleries, workshops and the Stirling Prize-winning Laban Centre. Up the hill in ever-so-smart Blackheath Village, the wide open spaces of the heath itself plus a weekly farmer's market and regular classical and acoustic music at the conservatoire.

Finally, half an hour by DLR to Stratford, the site of the 2012 Olympics; Europe's largest regeneration project leaving an extraordinary legacy of world-class sports venues and a new Eurostar station, making Greenwich to the rest of Europe a breeze.



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
### **TRANSPORT**

Train: There are two stations in the town centre, Greenwich (National Rail, Overground & DLR) and Cutty Sark (DLR), with fast, direct trains to Canary Wharf, London Bridge and Cannon Street and one-change connections to City, Gatwick & Luton Airports. Also, in preparation for 2012, Stratford and the Olympics will be less than 1/2 an hour away on the DLR.

River: Greenwich Pier runs riverbus services to, among others, Canary Wharf (8 mins), London Bridge (21 mins) and Waterloo (40 mins).


Bus: 7 routes linking Greenwich to Central and much of South East London. Plus 2 night buses.
